

Council Minutes  
Work Shop  
June 5, 2017  
7:00 P.M.

The Council of the City of Gordon held a work shop on Monday, June 5, 2017 at 7:00 p.m. at the City Annex located at 108 Elam Street. The purpose of the work shop was for the presentation of a meter reading device. Members present were Mayor Mary Ann Whipple-Lue and Council Members Mr. Bruce Daniel, Mr. Freddie Densley, Mr. Terry Eady, Mrs. Barbara Towles, Mrs. Doretha Whipple, and Mr. George Wynn.

Lee Smallwood with Suez Utility Service Company introduced himself and Andre Noel and stated what they would be going over tonight would be AMI Metering Asset Management. He then turned presentation over to Mr. Noel.

Mr. Noel stated they are looking to propose a meter servicing solution to assist the city in meter reading. A video overview of services they can provide was presented. Mr. Noel then highlighted the benefits of the system.

Suez is offering an Asset Management Program, 100% financed, AMI Metering Installation Service with a maintenance program. The cost is approximately \$90,000.00 per year for fifteen years. There is a 15 year warranty on everything associated with the system.

The need of a price breakdown for each section of the system/service was discussed.

City Clerk asked permission from City Council to do summary minutes for this work shop. No opposition was posed.
